

**The Louisiana Office of Community Development/Disaster Recovery Unit (OCD/DRU) is advertising to receive qualified applicants to serve as Infrastructure Manager.**

Position Description - This position is responsible for the effective, efficient performance of the Infrastructure Program within the Disaster Recovery Unit for the State of Louisiana. As the agency responsible for oversight of recovery programs in the aftermath of four recent hurricanes, the OCD/DRU coordinates with federal, state and local governmental partners as well as non-profits and the private sector engaged in recovery efforts.

This position involves design and implementation of processes for program funds delivery, compliance monitoring, project monitoring, client assistance, and all other activities necessary to deliver Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Infrastructure funds from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to the intended recipients in a manner consistent with all applicable laws.

In order to accomplish the above, this position directs the activities of the staff of the Infrastructure group, as well as any contracted workers. This position is responsible for maintaining working relationships with the intended recipients, including members of affected parish governments and school boards. This position works with other groups within the Disaster Recovery Unit, as well as other units of state government, to ensure that all the State's efforts that might impact the work of the Infrastructure group are complementary and coordinated. This position performs all other necessary, related, and assigned duties as required. This position currently manages and oversees the implementation of hundreds of recovery projects in excess of \$1.5 billion.

Qualifications - This position requires extensive experience with program management; ability to lead and direct staff; experience in the areas of public facilities and infrastructure improvement, transportation, community development, and building construction programs. Required skills include complex problem solving, communication, and program and personnel management. Knowledge of federal programs and Community Development Block Grants is preferred. The OCD/DRU employs highly motivated individuals who share a deep commitment to ensure that Louisiana rebuilds safer, stronger and smarter.
